

• 57% of respondents expressed mixed-used development (possibly containing residential) as a positive





Neighborhood Improvements:

• Better street lighting 52.34%


• Improved sidewalks 58.56%







Percent by Household Type





Housing Pairing Recommendations

Aspiration X: Supporting Quality Growth


Objective: Expand housing development to ensure accessible, livable options for all residents.

- **1.X.X** Update City zoning and subdivision ordinances to create sustainable and resilient development.
- 2.X.X Update the City's zoning ordinance to create a new mixed-use zoning district and apply it between I-35 Frontage Road and Culberson Street, from Highway 82 and Downtown.
- 2.X.X Create and adopt a clear, user-friendly set of city-wide design guidelines to support predictable, efficient, and high-quality development outcomes
- **3.X.X** Implement the priority capital projects identified in the City's Water Master Plan
- **3.X.X** Prioritize and fund the replacement and upgrading of critical stormwater drainage infrastructure based on the Cooke County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan.




How would you rate the overall appearance of downtown Gainesville?

Downtown Revitalization Pairing Recommendations

Aspiration X: Improve public spaces to encourage activity and gathering.

- **3.X.X** Implement a comprehensive downtown parking management strategy that includes clear wayfinding signage, a digital map of public lots, and partnerships with private property owners to share parking during offpeak hours.
- 4.X.X Create chill streets by planting trees, shrubs, and native landscaping.
- **5.X.X** Implement a downtown streetscape improvement program focused on adding pedestrian-scale lighting, benches, public art, and other amenities that encourage people to stroll and gather.
- **5.X.X** Develop and fund a collaborative Downtown Activation Program that includes: 1) A coordinated marketing strategy to promote all downtown happenings, 2) The creation of new signature festivals, and 3) Partnerships with local organizations to sponsor live entertainment.
- **5.X.X** As part of the city-wide design guidelines, create specific standards for historic downtown. Additionally, launch a public art program to beautify public spaces, such as alleys, with culturally relevant murals.
- **5.X.X** Develop and launch a comprehensive historic walking tour program, featuring both self-guided options (via a mobile app or printed maps) and volunteer-led tours.
